Matanuska Valley's 34th Christmas Bird Count (CBC) Results

The 2013 Matanuska Valley Christmas Bird Count (CBC) took place on Sunday, December 15th. During the CBC, Field Teams and Feeder Counters at home counted all the birds that they saw within the Matanuska Valley Count Circle, a 15 mile diameter circle centered on Four Corners.
